APA 6th referencing style What is a direct quotation? A direct quotation reproduces word-for-word material taken directly from another author's work, or from your own previously published work. If

the quotation is fewer than 40 words, incorporate it into your paragraph and enclose it in double quotation marks.

#### Direct quotations - APA 6th referencing style - Library ...

For a direct quotation, always include a full citation (parenthetical or narrative) in the same sentence as the quotation, including the page number (or other location information, e.g., paragraph number). Place a parenthetical citation either immediately after the quotation or at the end of the sentence.

#### **Quotations - APA Style**

Numbers in parentheses refer to specific pages in the APA 6th Edition manual. How to Cite a Direct Quote (pp.170-171) When you incorporate a direct quotation into a sentence, you must cite the source. Fit quotations within your sentences, enclosed in quotation marks, making sure the sentences are grammatically correct.

When you include a sentence or words reproduced from a text (book, article, etc.) in your writing, you should follow the APA style for direct quotations. Your in-text citation for direct quotations should include author, date, and page numbers. Short direct quotes (fewer than 40 words)

#### In-text citation - APA 6th Referencing Style Guide ...

APA in-text citation is generally written with the last name of the author and year of publication separated by a comma inside the parentheses, but for direct quotations, the page or paragraph number has to be included.

#### **APA Quote Citation | APA Format**

APA Style uses parenthetical, author-date citations. After a quote, add parentheses containing the author's name, the year of publication, and the page number of the work. For quotations that are on one page, type "p." before the page number, and for quotations that start on one page and end on another page, use "pp." as in the examples below.

#### APA 6th Ed: In-Text Citations - Citation Resources ...

The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when "paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work" (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.

Only use page numbers for a direct quote. Make sure the source information in parentheses matches with your works cited. The punctuation for the sentence goes AFTER the parenthesis. If your quote is forty words or more, set it off in a block text by beginning a new line, indenting one inch, and do not add quotation marks.

APA citation basics. When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, like, for example, (Jones, 1998). One complete reference for each source should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

Citing a specific part of source (chapter, tables, figures, or equations) When citing a particular part of a source, it is important to indicate the page, chapter, figure, table, or equation. Remember to

always give page numbers for direct quotations (see APA, section 6.19, p. 179).

The sixth edition of APA style also had the exact way to cite the quote in the reference section of the paper. If the quote is longer than 40 words, it must start on a new line. Indent the quote by 5 spaces, or a 1/2-inch by Microsoft Word's ruler. Double-space the quote, and do not use quotation marks.

Direct Quote Quoted material should be reproduced word-for-word. Always include the author's last name, year of publication, and page number (s). Use 'p.' for a single page number (Example: p.

### Direct Quote - APA Style Guide - LibGuides at Western ...

Typically, if you include a direct quote, you also need a pinpoint citation that allows your reader to go straight to the source and read the original quote. In a regular parenthetical citation, place a comma after a year, then the abbreviation "p." (for a single page) or "pp." (for a page range), followed by the page or pages where the quote appears. With direct quotes, the parenthetical citation occurs outside the closing quotation marks but inside the closing punctuation for the sentence.

#### How to Properly Cite a Web Article in APA - wikiHow

Both the American Psychological Association (APA) and the Modern Language Association (MLA)

require that you include parenthetical citations within the text whenever you paraphrase or quote directly from a source. This can be problematic when citing Wikipedia articles, which have no credited authors, no date of publication and no page numbers.
