Mitigating Teacher Shortages: Teacher Leadership

Assess what teachers already know and understand. Be relevant to teachers' work, examining concrete problems of practice and practical solutions. Involve teachers in posing questions, seeking data, and drawing conclusions through cycles of inquiry (Nelson, Slavit, Perkins, & Hathorn, 2008).
