The pyramid, which is now 455 feet (138 meters) tall, is known as the "Great Pyramid" and was considered by ancient writers to be a wonder of the world. The pyramid of Khafre (the reign started around 2520 B.C.) was only slightly smaller than Khufu's, but it stood on higher ground. Many scholars believe that the monument to the Sphinx, which lies near the pyramid of Khafre, was built by Khafre, and that the face of the Sphinx was modeled after him.
