Micro Teach Lesson Plan

Time to 15 Minutes: Reteach. For Students 3rd - 4th. In this telling time in 15 minute increments worksheet, students use the analog clocks to help them find the time using 15 minute increments. Students write the digital time in the blanks in the first set.

Planning a Training Session

Over-plan the class. Knowing that you have plenty to do is a much better problem than not having enough. Even though you have a timeline, plan on the underside. If something might take 20 minutes, allow it 15. You never know what your students will just whiz through! The easiest thing to do is to come up with a quick concluding game or discussion.

A micro-teaching session should be a complete instructional segment and should deal with topics that will provide new learning for the other participants.
