In July 2017, I estimated the number of flat earthers to be 300 million, which was roughly 4% of the world population, or roughly 6% of the adult population.Today, the data from polls and surveys, show roughly 10% of the adult population to be flat earthers, which is roughly 7.5% of the entire world population (7.6 billion).

FlatWorld is a publisher of college-level textbooks and educational supplements founded in 2007 as Flat World Knowledge by Eric Frank and Jeff Shelstad. It was acquired at the end of 2016 by Alastair Adam and John Eielson and its company headquarters was moved from Washington, DC to Boston, MA. The company originally offered every textbook published free using online delivery under the open content paradigm, but in November 2012, the company announced that it will no longer offer a free version
